## **PRESCHOOL**

Please send a complete change of clothes for your child. (socks, pants, shirt, and underwear)  
2 large boxes of Kleenex Ultra Soft tissues

## **KINDERGARTEN**

Please label with your kindergartner's name and send the following items:

Paint smock or oversized T-shirt (short sleeved please)  
Backpack or tote bag - Large enough for full sized library books  
Bathroom or Beach towel (needs to fit into a gallon zip-lock bag)  
Pencil/supply box  
2 spiral notebook (50-75 pages)  
1 adult sized shoe box  
Athletic Shoes for PE days (No Crocs/Flip-flops/Heelies)

The following items will be "community items"- please do not label:

2 bottles of liquid school glue  
Children's scissors must be ROUND tipped  
2 palettes of 8 to 10 watercolor paints (Crayola)  
2 large boxes of Kleenex tissues  
washable markers  
5-10 glue sticks  
2 boxes of 16 count box of crayons  
1-2 bottles of liquid hand sanitizer  
8-10 count colored pencils  
1 boxes of #2 pencils

## **OPTIONAL**

If you are able to help with these items that would be wonderful:

2 rolls of masking tape  
1 roll of Scotch tape (or other "clear" tape)  
1 box of "freezer" zipper type sandwich size bags  
1 box of "freezer" zipper type gallon size bags  
1 ream of white paper

Plastic supply box (small enough to fit in desk) (labeled)  
5 pocket folders (red, blue, yellow, green, orange) (labeled)  
1 backpack (to be brought to school every day) (labeled)  
3 wide-lined composition notebooks (black/white cover)  
Athletic Shoes for PE days (No Crocs/Flip-flops/Heelies)
