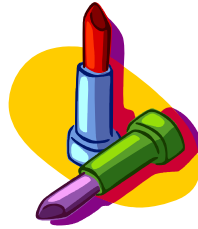


K-12 Opportunities at The College of Engineering, University of Iowa

Dates: June 15-19 and/or June 22-26

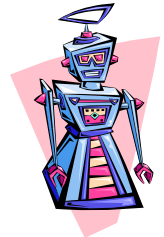
Fees: \$250/registrant
