Daily Schedule:

Meet Your Instructors:

Havilah Meinel has previously worked on theatrical productions in Iowa, Maine, New York, Los Angeles, London (England), and Maryland. Havilah obtained her BA in English and Theatre from the University of Iowa, and her Masters in Education from the University of Maryland. To date, she has directed 15 theatrical productions (both musical and non-musical) and performed in countless others. Her current accolades include: *Outstanding Director of A Comedy* in 2005, and the *Golden Bell Award* for excellence in teaching in 2007. She has been teaching high school theatre for seven years, and is currently the Theatre Director at West High School, in Iowa City, Iowa.

Megan Snyder is the Owner and Director of Debut Dance & Pilates. Megan graduated from the University of Iowa in 2006 with a BA in Dance. While at the U of I, Megan actively pursued performance opportunities through the Dance Department and spent three years on the U of I Dance Team cheering on the Hawkeyes and competing nationally. For the past 5 years, Megan choreographed award winning state competition routines for the Regina Dance Team and has established her very own Debut Dance Team at her studio. Megan has also trained with STOTT Pilates and has teaches both mat and reformer classes to clients of all ages and abilities. This past fall, Megan choreographed the West High Musical, "Once Upon a Mattress".

What to Wear:
